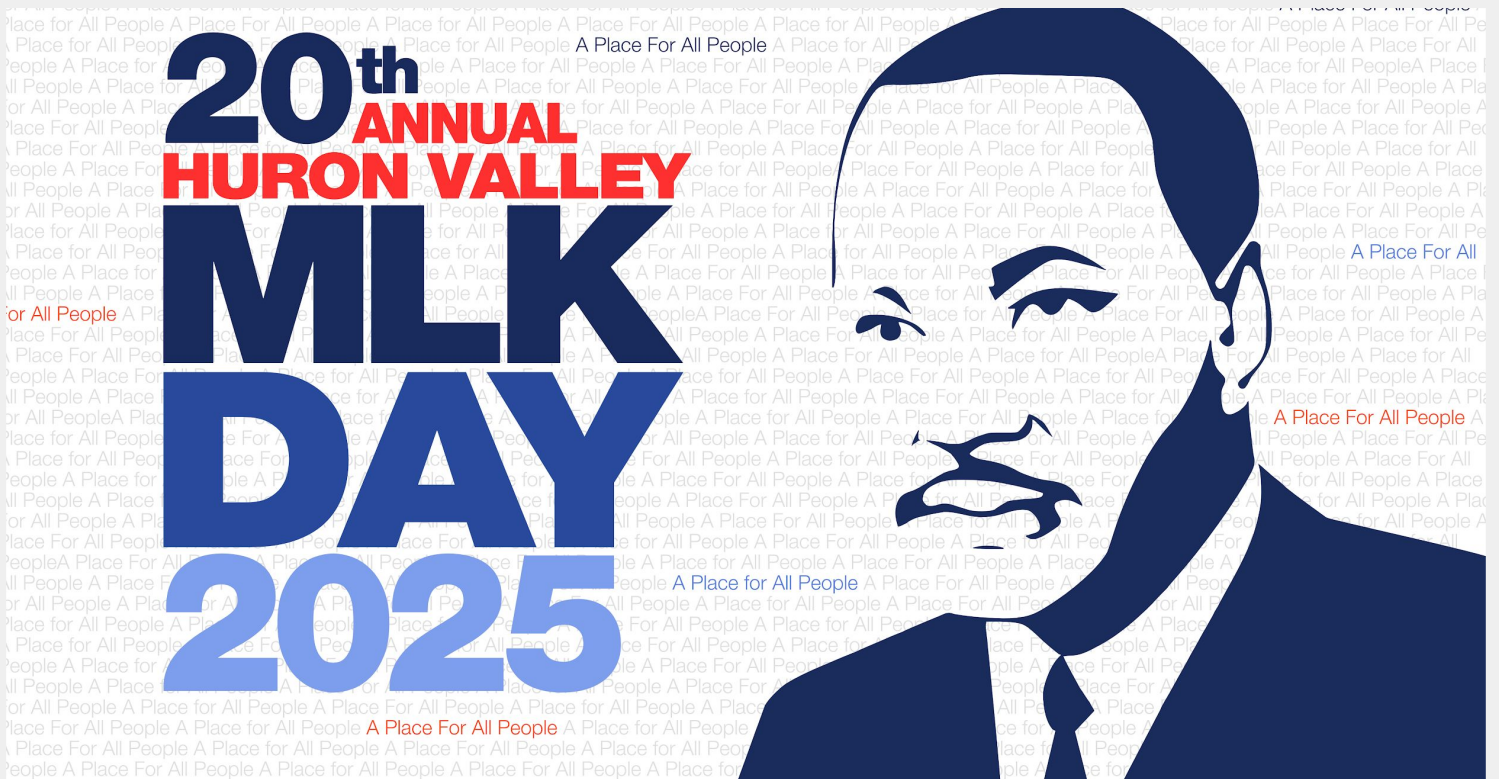


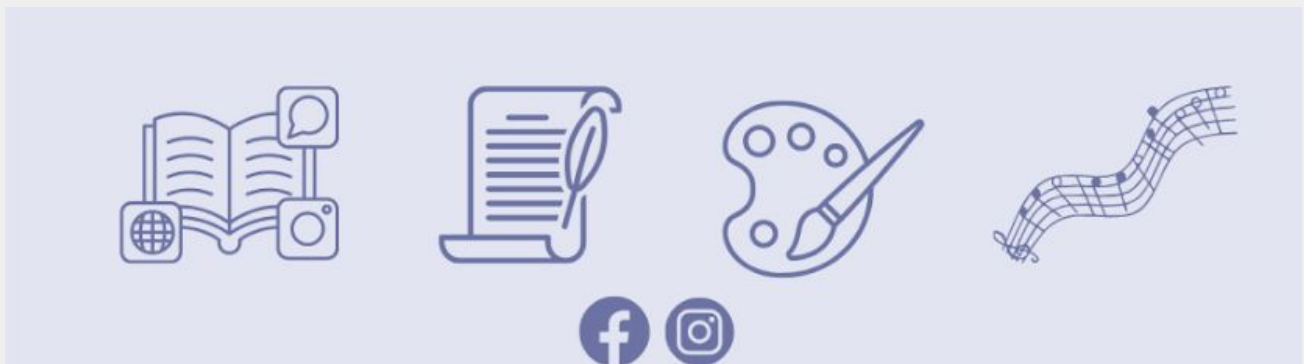

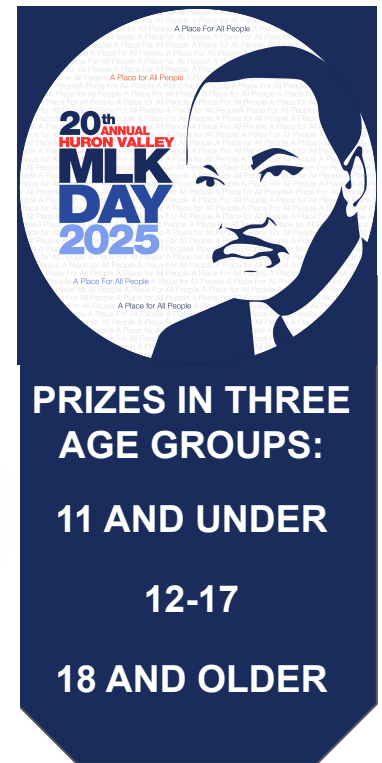

HOW TO ENTER:

- All entries must include artist, age and contact information.
- Written pieces should be 500 words or less. Speeches and performances (submitted by youtube or other link), 5 minutes or less.
- All work should explore the theme of the event: “A Place for All People.” Create an original work of art, essay, poem, song, or other multimedia submission expressing your interpretation of the contest theme.
- Winners and selected submissions will be showcased at the Suzanne Haskew Arts Center (The SHAC) during the week before the March on Main Street.
